Radiology Technologist Part Time Position

JOB SUMMARY

- Part time clinical position available. Reports to the Physician/Coordinator/Director. Operates basic
 radiologic equipment determining the quality and quantity of ionizing radiation to make quality
 radiographs on injured and/or sick patients as directed by physicians following accepted policies and
 procedures under the direction of radiologists.
- Position also carries requires responsibilities for assisting in general office tasks and patient care duties
 - Verifies patient information by interviewing patient, recording medical history, and confirming purpose of visit. Prepares patients for examination by performing preliminary physical tests; taking blood pressure, weight, and temperature; and reporting patient history summary. Other assistance and application of patient care as ordered by the attending physician.
 - Responsible for administrative as well as clinical tasks, such as maintaining patient records, preparing patients and rooms for examination, assisting physicians with exams, and performing front-desk tasks.

Education and Experience

- The knowledge, skills and abilities as indicated below are normally acquired through graduation from an approved school of radiology technology with subsequent registration by the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists (ARRT) and certification by the State Board of Health.
- Position Qualifications Minimum Education: Associates degree in radiological sciences or certificate from an AMA approved school. Registered by the American Registry of Radiologic Technology. Valid Indiana State License to operate radiograph producing equipment. Preferred Experience: 2 years prior experience as a Radiology Technologist. Knowledge of CPT and ICD-10 coding.
